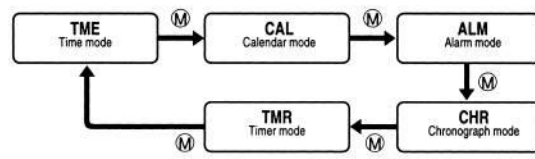
Analog time setting position



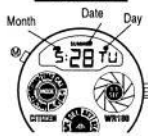
